

TODAY IN HUNGARY

- Paramilitaries close to the Jobbik party march through Roma settlements with snarling dogs, torches, and, in some cases, weapons, calling for the extermination of Roma (per Amnesty International).
- Perpetrators of violence against Roma, including beatings, bombings, and murders, routinely remain unidentified and avoid prosecution.
- Roma do not have equal access to education, employment, health care, or other benefits of civil society.
- The European Court of Human Rights ruled that Hungary violated human rights by segregating Romani children in special schools.
- The right-wing Jobbik party gained 17% of the seats in Parliament despite promoting hate speech and anti-Roma propaganda.
- Government silence in the face of fascist, xenophobic, and genocidal threats is intolerable!
